MINUTES for the Mission Directorate Meeting (Video Conference) of National AYUSH Mission (NAM) for the year 2021-22

1. The Mission Directorate Meeting (Through Video Conference) of the National AYUSH Mission (NAM) for the year 2021-22 was held on 20-09-2021 under the Chairmanship of ShriVaidya Rajesh Kotecha,Secretary, AYUSH, to consider the State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) of Himachal Pradesh, Nagaland, Goa, Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh. List of the participants is enclosed at Annexure-I.

2. At the outset, Shri D.Senthil Pandiyan, Joint Secretary, AYUSH welcomed the representatives of State/UT Governments to the Mission Directorate meeting and briefed that the State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) for the States/UTs ofHimachal Pradesh, Nagaland, Goa, Uttarakhand and **Uttar Pradesh**have already been appraised during the Appraisal Committee meeting and detailed observations were communicated to the States/UTs.

3. Further, it was also informed to the Mission Directorate that during the appraisal meetings a detailed review of progress of Expenditure and PFMS Implementation has been carried out. It was suggested that State /UT Governments have to expedite the progress of expenditure and to ensure submission of UCs of atleast 75% of the previous released Grants-in-Aid. Further, it is also required to fulfill the compliance of guidelines regarding PFMS implementation which are the necessary criteria for release of grant as per the direction issued by the Department of Expenditure.

4. After that a brief presentation has been made by Joint Advisor (Ayu) for each State highlighting the aspects of

- i. Year-wise Progress of expenditure and status of UCs submitted under NAM
- ii. Status of AYUSH HWCs
- iii. Status of setting up of upto 50 Bedded integrated AYUSH Hospitals
- iv. Status of New AYUSH Educational Institutions.
- v. Status of submitted SAAP during 2021-22.
- vi. Status of implementation of PFMS.

The State-wise detailed observation are enclosed in ANNEXURE-II.

ANNEXURE-II

<u>Uttar Pradesh</u>

Mission Directorate reviewed the Expenditure & Utilization Certificates status of the State Govt. against the previous year's grants-in-aid released to the State under the NAM scheme, Status of PFMS, Status of HWCs, Status of State Annual Action Plan and made the following observations and recommendations:

Expenditure & Utilization Certificates

- **Status of Expenditure**: Under NAM, an amount of Rs. 80709.557 Lakhs has been approved from the year 2015-16 till date. State Govt. has reported an expenditure of Rs. 60088.195 Lakhs (74.44%). Further, it is observed that Rs.741.62 lakhs of Centre share is lying pending with State Treasury. In this regard, State Govt. has informed that they will look into the matter and take necessary steps to expedite the process of withdrawal of Centre share at the earliest.
- Status of Utilization Certificates:State Govt. has submitted Utilization Certificates (UCs) for Rs. 31947.272 Lakhs (75.22 %)till date. State Govt. is required to submit UCs of Rs. 10029.535 lakhs against UC due (Central Share) at the earliest.

Status of PFMS

- State has designated State Nodal Agency (SNA) and Single Nodal Account also opened but not mapped with PFMS.
- State has not opened zero balance/ virtual account for the Implementing Agencies (IAs) down the ladder.
- Transfer of unspent balance from Implementing Agencies to SNA not yet completed.
- State Govt. is required to update unspent balance as reflected in the PFMS portal.
- State Govt. is required to transfer the Central Share received earlier in its account in the RBI to the Concerned SNA's account.
- State Govt. is required to utilize 75% of both Central Share and State Share grant in aid released earlier.
- Grants-in-aid will be released to only those States/UTs who comply with the directions issued by D/o Expenditure OM dated 23.03.2021.

In this regard, State Govt. was suggested to complete the procedures for the implementation of PFMS & update unspent balance as reflected in the PFMS portal and it was also suggested that bank account opened should be the savings bank account.

AYUSH HWCs

- i. The Ministry has given the target of 210, 360, 405 AYUSH Dispensaries for the year 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22 respectively (total 975 AYUSH HWCs) to be upgraded as AYUSH HWCs.
- ii. As per the proposal received from the State Govt., the Ministry had approved for up gradation of 324 Ayush Dispensaries as Ayush HWCs in the year 2019-20 and 268 Ayush Dispensaries as Ayush HWCs in the year 2020-21 in the state of Uttar Pradesh.
- iii. As per the provision of operational guideline of AYUSH HWC, Phase II (year 2021-22) will be sanctioned after 100% of HWCs sanctioned in 2019-20 and 50% of HWCs sanctioned in 2020-21 are made operational. So, the State Govt. had to operationalize minimum 458 AYUSH HWCs for being eligible for Phase II. As per the progress report submitted by the UT Govt., 12 AYUSH HWCs have been made functional under progressive category.
- iv. The matter was discussed during the Mission Directorate meeting and it was assured by the State representative that the State Govt. will be able to make the approved 500 AYUSH HWCs operational by the end of October 2021.
- v. Accordingly, the Mission Directorate in principally approved the proposal of State Govt. However, the fund will be released only after operationalization of Minimum 458 AYUSH HWCs.

New AYUSH Education Institutes

During the Appraisal Committee Meeting held on 06.09.2021, the State Representative informed that they want to establish 2 new AYUSH Educational Institutes through NAM scheme. Accordingly, it was highlighted during the meeting that as per the latest approval of the Cabinet, State may avail financial assistance of ₹7000.00 lakhs as one-time non-recurring assistance for civil works & Equipments, furniture for Setting up of new AYUSH Educational Institutions. It was suggested that State Govt. has to submit the proposal as per the provision of NAM guidelines.

Accordingly, the State Govt. has forwarded their request through email dated 16.09.2021 vide letter No.289/299a/Mi.Ni./2021-22 Lucknow dated 16.09.2021 regarding establishment of Ayurvedic Medical College and Hospital at Ayodhya and Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital at Varanasi.

Keeping in view above, in- principle approval has been accorded by the Mission Directorate subject to the condition that the State Govt. may furnish the relevant documents related to

ownership of land, Detailed Project Report (DPR) along with the amount proposed for establishment of these colleges.

Status of State Annual Action Plan (SAAP)

The State Government has submitted the SAAP for an amount of Rs. 58019.571 Lakhs for the year 2021-22 against communicated resource pool of Rs. 14891.8 Lakhs.

The State Govt. of Uttar Pradesh has not fulfilled the conditionalities of implementation of PFMS against the direction issued by the Department of Expenditure vide OM dated 23-03-2021. Accordingly, Mission Directorate decided to consider State Annual Action Plan for approval of the total amount as per the provision of NAM guidelines subject to condition that State Govt has to fulfill conditions of Department of Expenditure i.e. (i) comply with the procedure of implementation of PFMS, and (ii) submission of Utilization Certificate & Expenditure upto 75% against the previous year's released grant- in aid as per following details:
